Spring ...

Welcome to the first Deepdale News, a quarterly newspaper and guide, celebrating Burnham Deepdale, a small historic coastal village at the heart of the beautiful North Norfolk Coast. We thought this would be a useful free paper, helping you discover the services and attractions in the village, and the events we are hosting.

Spring is one of our favourite times of the year here in North Norfolk. Our big skies are brighter for longer. The planted flowers, hedges and trees begin to wake up with buds & blossom. The salt marsh shifts from muted browns to fresh green. Winter seasonal visitors say goodbye, and the Spring visitors, such as swallows and swifts, begin to fly in. Our event calendar comes alive too ... music gigs, pop up shops, and tasty specials in The Nest Cafe.

For visitors arriving at this time of year, there's a sense of catching the coast just as it wakes. Mornings often begin with a silver mist drifting low across the creeks, the air sharp with sea salt and

birdsong. Brent geese linger on the marshes before their onward journeys, while oystercatchers and avocets patrol the mudflats with quiet determination. Walkers heading out along the coastal path towards Wells-next-the-Sea or Hunstanton are accompanied by the rhythmic hush of the tide and the distant cry of gulls. It is restorative, elemental, and unmistakably Norfolk.

Regular visitors to Burnham Deepdale will have noticed some changes to the village for 2026. There are two new offerings at Dalegate Market. The Nest Cafe opened its doors in mid February, and mother & daughter owners, Debs & Kate, have completely refurbished the space, creating a fabulously warm welcoming cafe, which we are sure you'll enjoy. Stephanie has opened Joyful, a new shop selling crystals, plants and more. Both new businesses would love you to visit.

Keep an eye on the events programme in the village ...

Deepdale Camping & Rooms, Dalegate Market and Deepdale Farm all host events through Spring. March is always a fun month as Whirligig Norfolk Ceilidh

Band join us in the Brick Barn for the Deepdale Barn Dance on Saturday 28th. Lots of entertaining dancing will ensue, and you are welcome to join us. The John Ward Trio take to the Brick Barn stage on Saturday 18th April for a live music gig.

Did You Know? - The font in St Mary's Church spent decades in a rector's garden



St Mary's Church

This Saxon round tower church (pre-Conquest of 1066) is open every day for visitors to enjoy its lovely interior. Round towers are unusual and mostly found in Norfolk. There are two others close by.

The Norman stone font depicts the farming seasons, and you can enjoy the collection of Medieval Glass ... Can you find the man in the moon?

The church is usually open from about 9am til dusk. Services are held most Sunday mornings, see the notice board for times.

Norfolk Coast Path

You can now walk 112 miles around the whole of the Norfolk coast along the Norfolk Coast Path, part of the King Charles III England Coast Path.

Head West towards Brancaster, Titchwell, Thornham, Holme and Hunstanton. Head East to Burnham Overby Staithe, Holkham and Wells-next-the-Sea. Access from the track opposite Dalegate Market.

The path is a wonderful way to enjoy the coastal views of salt marshes, harbours, Scolt Head Island and nature reserves.
